

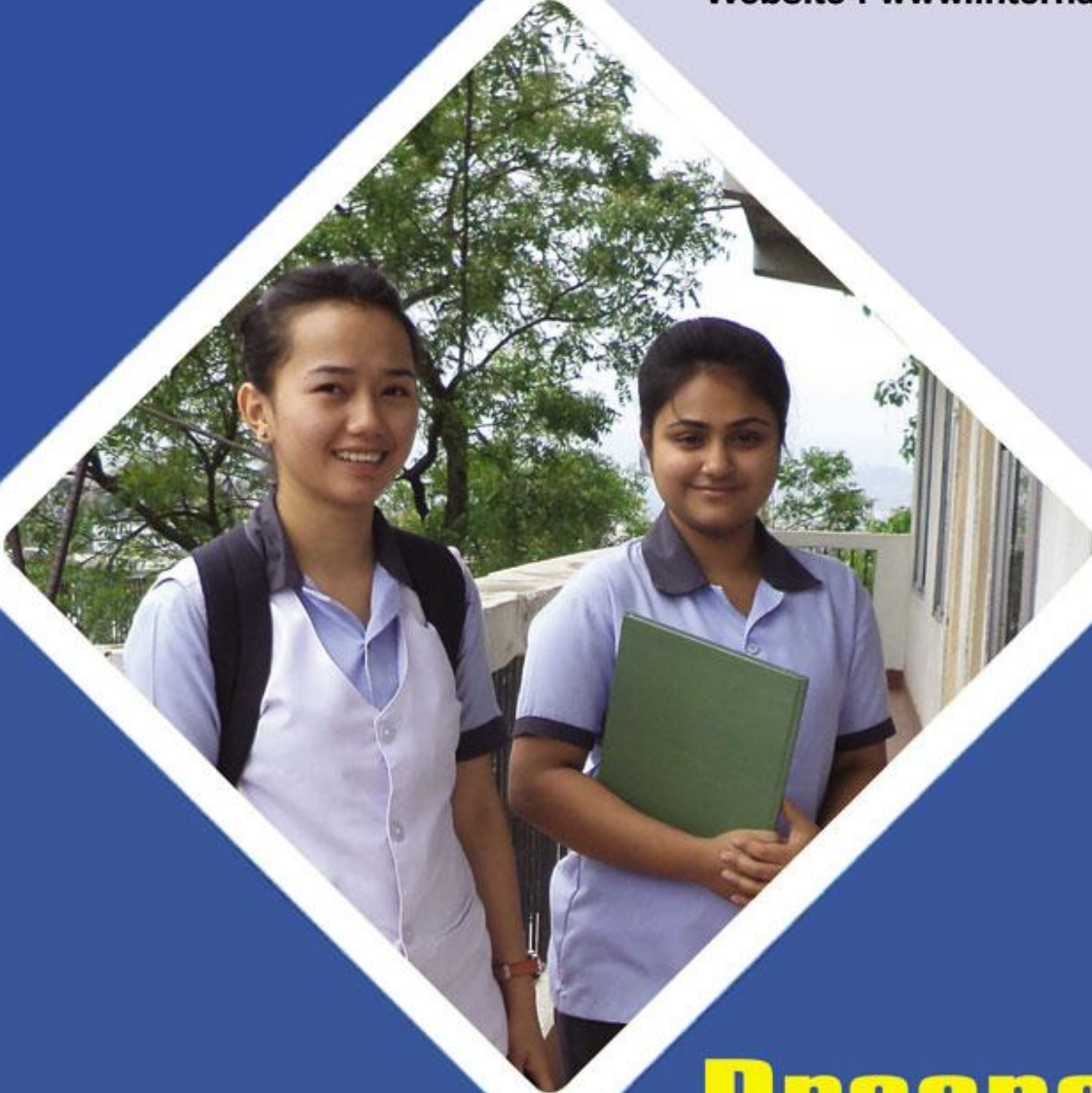

PROFILE OF APOLLO HOSPITALS GUWAHATI (The Parent Hospital of the School & College)

Established in the year 1999, inaugurated by late Surabala Bordoloi, wife of late Bharat Ratna Gopinath Bordoloi the first Chief Minister of undivided Assam, Apollo Hospitals Guwahati (previously International Hospital) today has earned a name and fame across the country in patient care especially in the disciplines of Nephrology, Gastroenterology, Urology, Paediatrics, Paediatric Surgery, Neurosciences, high end Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Surgery, Laparoscopic surgeries apart from all other supporting disciplines.

Within a span of a decade and half, Apollo Hospitals Guwahati unit: International Hospital has grown by nearly 5 times in terms of bed strength; in 2010, the Hospital developed the capability to conduct Kidney Transplantation and the number of transplantations has already crossed hundred and the number is growing every month.

The Hospital has best Cardiology facilities with modern state of Art CATHLAB and Support services. This Hospital also has 24 x 7 Accident & Emergency services and best Critical Care Unit.

Clinical Facility:

Permissions are obtained from different government hospitals for sending students for clinical experiences.

The students will be posted in the following Hospitals as per the planned schedule

3. Mohendra Mohan Chowdhury Hospital-Panbazar, Guwahati.
4. Marwari Maternity Hospital and Research centre- Athgaon, Guwahati.
5. Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Institute of Mental Health- Tezpur.
6. Dr. Bhubaneswar Baruah Cancer Institute- Guwahati.
7. Khatri Community health Center, Khatri- Kamrup.
8. Capital State dispensary- Dispur, Guwahati.

TRANSPORT : There are buses and van to carry students for clinical posting. The vehicles Move as per the schedule of the curriculum.

UNIFORM : Students will be provided with two sets of uniform for clinical posting and two sets for attending classes as prescribed by the college. An identity card will be provided to every student. Students will bear the cost for the uniform including ID card.

EDUCATIONAL TRIP: Educational trip will be organized by the college during the course and students need to bear the cost.

VACATION : Eight week of vacation in short break will be enjoyed by the students. Sick leave is given as per the institutional policy.

HOSTEL: RULES AND REGULATION

- * Female students must reside in the hostel. Male students shall require to arrange their own accommodation.
- * Food will be served from a common mess. The mess shall be managed by hostel warden and hostel super will supervise. The overall management will be under the control of the principal.
- * Consumption of alcohol, narcotic drugs, betel nut, tobacco, smoking are prohibited strictly.
- * Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited.
- * Each and every boarder should maintain peace, harmony, integrity, discipline and sanctity of the hostel premises and the organization.
- * Rooms and surroundings of the hostel should be kept clean and hygienic.
- * Visitors are not allowed to be entertained inside the room.
- * Visitors are allowed to visit as per rules of the organization.
- * Night stay permission is given only in their own homes where their parent stay.
- * Students can visit their local guardian once in a month only on Sunday/ holiday with due permission.
- * Use of water and electricity must be logical.
- * For breakage or loss of hostel property students shall have to replace it immediately.
- * Any loss or damage of the college/hostel articles will be adjusted with the security money.
- * Boarders must abide by the rules and regulation of the hostel.

SELECTION PROCESS

After scrutinizing of application forms and testimonials by the scrutinizing board, shortlisted candidate will be called for selection test and interview on a fixed date. The date of test will be intimated to the eligible candidates. Those candidates who are successful in the test will be called to appear before a board for an interview. Interview will be conducted as per the score obtained in the test and the decision will be taken by the board which will be final for selecting the candidates. List of candidates selected for admission will be displayed on the notice board. All original certificates as mentioned in the prospectus are to be submitted at the time of admission for verification.

REGISTRATION UNDER SSUHS:

The candidates have to register their names in the university as per direction from SSUHS which will be notified as soon as the information is received from the university.

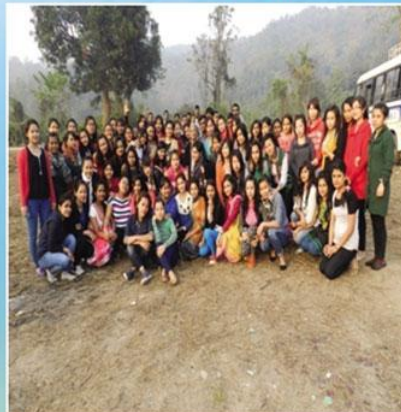

EXAMINATION

Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences will conduct the yearly final examination every year. The pre-final and the terminal examination will be conducted by the college. A student needs to obtain 50% marks in each subject (both theory and practical) to be declared pass.

Attendance: Attendance in Theory minimum 80% and practical 100%. If any student lacks attendance in the theory and clinical experience, he or she is not eligible to seat in the final examination, the deficient practical hours need to be fulfilled by doing make up duties.

Examination fee: Students will pay the examination fee as per instruction from SSUHS.

Criteria for passing:

- * A student will be declared pass only when s/he gets 50% marks in every subject- both in theory and in practical examination.
- * In English, students need to obtain only 40%, to be declared 'pass'.

Obtaining 'Class' 'Distinction' or' Honours'

- * No class is awarded on yearly performances.
- * The student is awarded the Honours scoring $\geq 75\%$ both theory and practical in subjectwise.
- * A class or distinction will be awarded only after the last final examination i.e. after 4 years of examination conducted by the university.

• FACILITIES AVAILABLE

PHYSICAL FACILITIES FOR THE B.SC(N) PROG.

1. Hostel Facilities:- A wellfurnished hostel with a mess facility is available.
2. Class Room:- Classroom with adequate space, light and ventilator are available.
3. Library:- A spacious library with adequate books and journals is available. There are both Indian and foreign journals for the students to enlighten their mind.
4. Teaching Aid: A number of teaching aids are available viz; overhead projector, LCD projector, slide projector, CPR manikin, Child birth simulator, dummies, internet facility etc.
5. Faculties:- There are teachers with qualification and experience to teach the students. Provisions are there to engage guest faculties when ever needed.

About the International Hospital School of Nursing:

International Hospital School of Nursing was established in the year 2009. The school is affiliated to Indian Nursing Council and the Assam Nurses', Midwives' and Health Visitors' Council. Five batches of students have successfully completed the course and now absorbed as staff nurse in different hospitals within and outside the country. Many of them are developing their career through further higher study. Another three batches of students with a capacity of 40 students are continuing their study in the school. The school follows the syllabus prescribed by the INC. The facilities provided to the students during study and training are as laid down in the syllabus formulated by INC.

ALL ABOUT THE B.Sc. Nursing COURSE

B.Sc(N) is a four year degree course with a uniform syllabus prepared by INC and approved by Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences. The syllabus has a definite objective and purpose. This is a well balanced course which will prepare a qualified graduate nurse who will be able to function as member of health care team.

COURSE INTAKE : Forty (40) students per batch

DURATION OF COURSE: FOUR YEARS INCLUDING THE INTERNSHIP PERIOD

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

1. Age: The candidate should complete 17 years of age by 31st December in this year.
2. Sex: Both male and female are eligible.
3. Minimum education:
10+2 passed with science with 45% marks in Physics, Biology and Chemistry.
5% of marks is relaxed for SC & ST Candidate.
4. Students will have to be medically fit.

MODE OF APPLICATION SUBMISSION

- Filled up application form must reach the office of the International Hospital College of Nursing, on or before the last date of submission as specified in the advertisement
- Following documents must be submitted along with the application forms.
 - Three self-attested passport sized photograph of the applicant.
 - HSLC and HSSLC marks sheets, pass certificates and admit card.
 - Birth Certificate
 - Character certificate from the head of institution last attended.
 - Caste certificate from appropriate authority
 - Undertaking from parent/legal guardian of candidate promising to meet all financial obligation of the candidate and organizational policy.
 - Permanent residential certificate (PRC)

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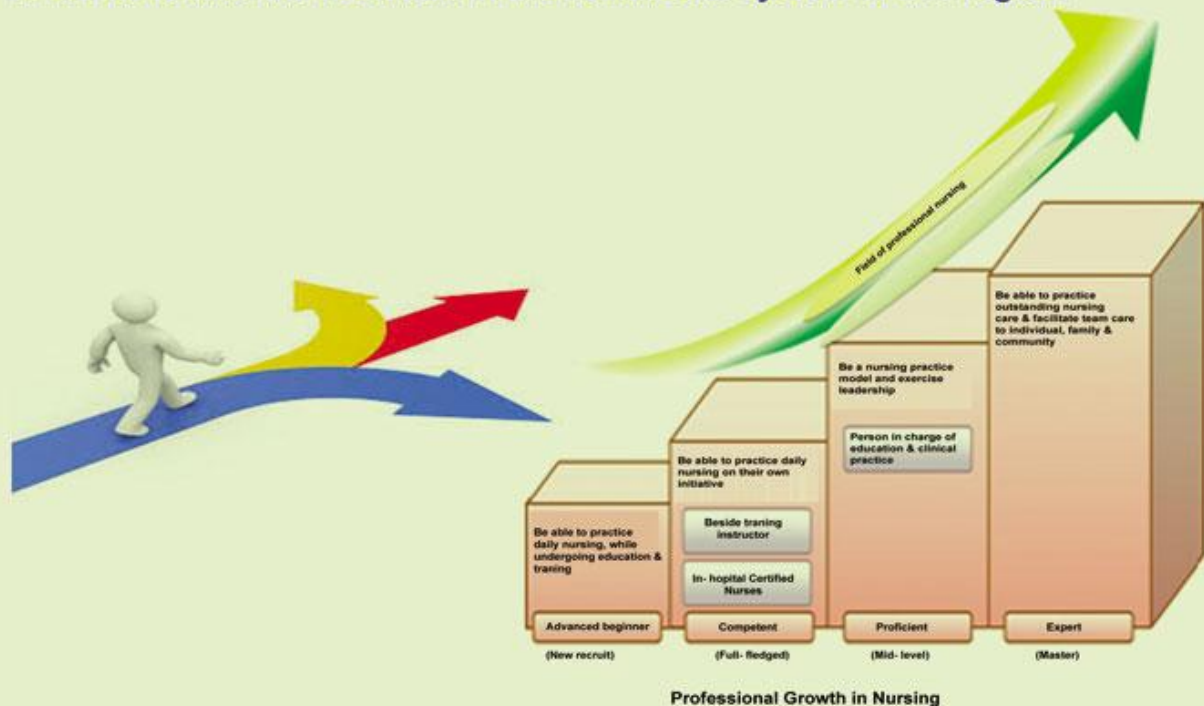


Introduction

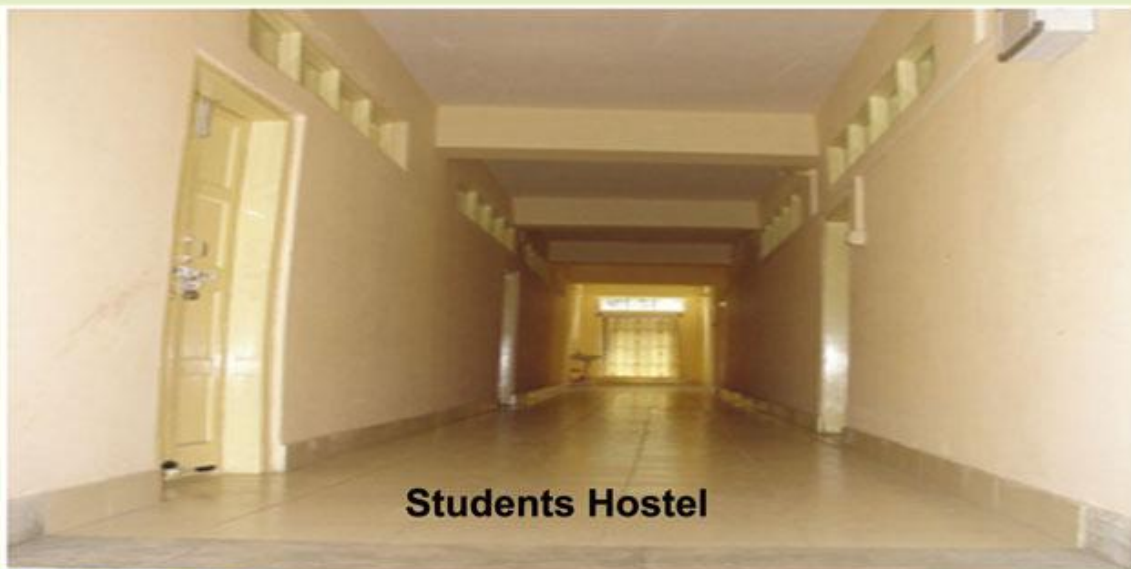
With an attached parent hospital with super specialities, the International Hospital College of Nursing will be able to prepare the students to take the front role in the health care system of this region.
